## **Uninstall Directions for Windows.**

The following will work on any windows based PC, including the MCS-touch-PCs. Please note if you are working on an MCS-Touch-PC you will need to go through the unlock procedure before getting started.

- 1. Double click on "My Computer" link on the Desktop.
- 2. Double click Local Disk (C:).
- 3. Double click on the Program Files folder.
- 4. Double click on the MCS folder.
- 5. Double click on the MCS-Connect folder.
- 6. Double click on the "unins000.exe" icon, this will start the uninstaller.
- 7. There will be a pop up asking "Are you sure you want to completely remove MCS-Connect and all of its components?". Click "Yes".
- 8. There will be a status bar as MCS-Connect uninstalls. Once completed there will be a pop-up "MCS-Connect was successfully removed from your computer.". Click "OK".
- 9. Uninstallation is now complete.
- 10. You can proceed to reinstalling the latest version of MCS-Connect.
- 11. If this was done on an MCS-Touch-PC you must relock the touchscreen after reinstallation of MCS-connect.

## **Uninstall Directions for Linux**

This will only work on the MCS-Touch 15.4. You must first unlock the touchscreen

- 1. Double click on MCS TOOLS
- 2. Click on the dropdown arrow next to Places
- 3. Select Directory Tree
- 4. Click on Ubuntu under directory tree
- 5. Double click on the MCS-Connect folder
- 6. Double click on the Uninstaller folder
- 7. Double click on uninstaller.jar wait a few seconds there is a bit of a delay.
- 8. Click on uninstall
- 9. When it says [Finished] in the grey bar click Quit
- 10. Now you can reinstall MCS-Connect for Linux.
- 11. After you re-install MCS connect re-lock the touch screen.
