MCS-CONFIG Version 9.04J 05/15/2013

Updates from previous versions:

New Features:

1. In ALL config types and versions when the main form is loaded the authorization popup is shown for all users. Changing this popup to not be shown for in house testing only.

Bug Fixes:

1. In ALL config types V11, V12, and V14 on the Authorization Information Screen if the Auth level that was entered is factory then the Admin auth code is visible and an Admin auth level is able to be saved. Resolution: Black out the row if the user level is factory for Admin and do not allow a factory user or below save an Admin level auth code.
2. In ALL config types V11 and V14 on the Setpoint Info screen under the Auth Level column if the memory location is set to a value other than 5, 10, 20, 30, or 35 the value is being left as is but the column is being set to View Only which should be saving 0 in the memory location. Resolution: In the Update function of the setpoint array when the columns value is set to View Only also set the memory location to 0. Also set the memory location to 0 when converting from V11 to V14.
3. In ALL config types V14 on the Setpoint Info screen under the BMS Writeable column setpoints 231-255 are not saving the check in the column after the row is clicked off. Resolution: When a V11 config is converted to a V14 config set the memory location to 0 instead of 255.
